You can help save the lives of unwanted dogs and cats in Raleigh County with as little as \$10 per month. The Lifesaver Fund is earmarked for spaying and neutering HSRC pets prior to their adoption. This will make a drastic difference in the unwanted dogs and cats in our area. It will also drastically cut down the number of animals coming into the HSRC shelter each year.



The HSRC currently pays about \$80 to \$100 to have a single animal altered. The goal of the Lifesaver Fund is to have enough money raised in reserve to spay and neuter each shelter pet prior to adoption. This will help to stop the cycle of unwanted cats and dogs in Raleigh County. The future goal of the program is to have enough money in the Lifesaver Fund to help alter the animals that belong to indigent residents. But the first step in this plan starts with you! ARE YOU A LIFESAVER?

Did you know that the number one cause of pet overpopulation is not having your pet spayed or neutered? When someone fails to have a pet spayed or neutered, or “fixed” as many people call it, dogs and cats have litters of puppies and kittens. In one year, one unaltered female cat and her offspring could have 12 offspring. And one unaltered female dog could have 16 offspring in just one year! But where do all of these unwanted animals go? The sad reality is that over 3 million dogs and cats nationwide end up in animal shelters and over 2.4 million healthy dogs and cats are euthanized each year because there are not enough homes for them.

The problem also touches home. In 2015, it is estimated that over 30,000 animals were euthanized in West Virginia due to lack of space. And many more animals perish before they even reach a shelter.

But there is a simple and effective solution—spaying and neutering. And you can help us fix Raleigh County!



THE PLAN

The Humane Society of Raleigh County has decided to lead Raleigh County by example. All dogs and cats adopted from the shelter will be altered prior to adoption. This will cut down on unwanted pets in Raleigh County and help to ensure that adopters do not have an added burden of having to have their new pets fixed.

We are asking for volunteers who would like to help the HSRC save lives!! This is the best solution for Raleigh County but it does come with a price tag. The HSRC will have to have enough money in reserve to fix each animal that is adopted from our shelter. Becoming a lifesaver will help the HSRC ensure these pets are fixed prior to adoption. Depending on the success of the program, we hope to expand to help indigent Raleigh County citizens get their pets fixed. We are simply asking for a repeating monthly donation that will be earmarked for the Lifesaver Fund. These payments can be set up through Paypal or by automatic debit at the shelter.
